The Volf Soccer Academy Ltd.'s Code of Conduct has been developed to ensure every player and parent understands the expectations that will be placed upon them with respect to commitment, behaviour and performance during the VSA program.

Code of Conduct

Volf Soccer Academy Ltd. is a professional organization. Players and parents are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner that is in keeping with representing VSA. Below is an outline of the expectations for both players and parents:

Players:

- 1. Players will demonstrate positive sportsmanship on and off of the field. This includes exercising positive self-control, graciously accepting the outcome of the training and treating all players and spectators with courtesy and respect.
- 2. Players will demonstrate respect for all players and coaches in behaviour and language. Profanity will not be tolerated.
- 3. Players will train and work on skill development as is appropriate for the age and competitive level of play for the team.

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- 4. Players will positively represent VSA on and off the field at home or away when involved with any event VSA is participating in.
- 5. Players will be respectful and take care of any sports venue used while training with VSA.
- 6. Players, in coordination with parents, are responsible for timely notification of lateness or absences from training and games to the coach or administrator.
- 7. Violence and abuse of any nature will not be tolerated.
- 8. Players are prohibited from the use of alcohol, illegal drugs and tobacco products while a member of VSA.

Parents:

- 1. Parents are not permitted on the field or to approach the coaching staff during or after practices or games. Any communication should begin via email where an appropriate meeting time will be scheduled.
- 2. Encourage positive sportsmanship by example. Remind fellow parents if they get inappropriately carried away with their emotions during training. Accept these reminders graciously when offered by other parents.
- 3. Be supportive--unconditionally--accept all efforts. The last the child wants to hear from you after a disappointing performance is what they did wrong.
- 4. Do not coach. Leave the coaching to the coaches.
- 5. Emphasize skill development. Take time to help your kids practice their skills and exercises at home.
- 6. Interact positively with other VSA parents. Set a good example for

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players indicating you can train assertively and still be respectful.

- 7. Minimize gossip and criticism of teammates, other players and coaches.
- 8. Volunteer for special events, participate in fundraisers, etc.
- 9. Encourage your child to have fun and enjoy his/her academy mates and the training.
